

DAME TROTT

The pantomime dame takes centre stage as a beloved comical character, traditionally portrayed by an actor. However, we remain open to casting an actress for this role if no suitable male candidates emerge during auditions. This flexible approach ensures we maintain the essence of the pantomime dame, delivering humour and charm to the performance. The actor/actress will engage in group singing, but we will not require any solo performances.

JACK TROTT

In our version of the pantomime, Jack Trott is both the Principal Boy and village idiot and can be performed by either an actor or an actress. While dancing is not part of the performance requirements, the emphasis on vocal talent remains. The Principal Boy will engage the audience with a lively duet alongside the actress who plays Princess Jill, as well as participate in group singing numbers.

PRINCESS JILL

The Principal Girl is played by an actress. Although they do not require to do any dancing, they are tasked with showcasing their vocal abilities in several ways. The actress will perform solos, group singing and a duet.

KING

The role of the king is played by an actor and they are not required to dance and they only sing in a group.

GENIE

The Genie is a minor role and is only required to sing in a group and is not required to dance.

BUTTERCUP

In a unique twist on traditional pantomime, the pantomime cow is brought to life by a single actor or actress, breaking away from the norm of requiring two performers for this beloved character. There is no singing or dancing required and it's an unspoken role

CITIZENS

The Citizens can be played by actors and actresses are required to sing in a group. There will be dance roles available as well as non-dance roles.

GUARDS

The guards can be played by actors and actresses and no dancing or singing is required.

OTHER ROLES

The following roles do not require any singing or dancing:
Harp and Blunderbore
